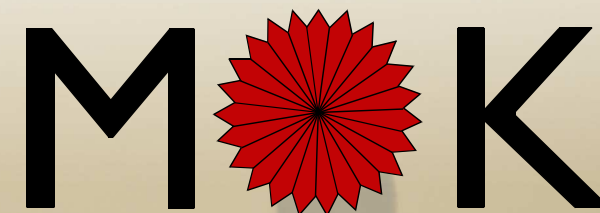

Our four orphanages and their tuition-free primary schools receive only minimal assistance from the state. They have to rely almost solely on private support. Whereas local patrons donate mostly clothes and food, our association offers financial assistance for new buildings and equipment, for education and health expenses.

The Land and her People

Myanmar (Burma), with its impressive cultural monuments and picturesque landscapes, might look like a paradise. Prolonged mismanagement and natural catastrophes have brought poverty and deprivation to the people. According to the UN it is one of the 20 least developed countries in the world. Against this background we have decided to help the most vulnerable and disadvantaged: the girls and boys who have lost their parents. In our orphanages they find a new and safe home as well as a brighter future.



Our Goals

For the last ten years we have been assisting deprived children to escape from the degrading cycle of unemployment, lack of education and poverty. We offer them:

-  Basic and Higher Education as well as targeted, practical training;
-  Improved general living conditions as well as sustained hygiene programs and health care;
-  Medium-term loans for former students when setting up a business.

About Us

We are a tax-exempted, charitable organization, registered with the local court and state tax authority in Frankfurt/Main. Our activities are dedicated to children's health and education in Myanmar (Burma). The association does not pay salaries, rent, travel expenses and consultancy fees. This strict policy makes us cost efficient.

Our projects in Myanmar are supervised by our Representative in Yangon, U Min Lwin Oo (Min Min).

Our Projects

Our orphanages offer primary schools, kindergartens, libraries, a training center for Diesel engines and computer training facilities. Several girls and boys attend universities. Together with the orphanages we assist them in finding employment. Some former students have successfully set up their own businesses with a medium-term loan from our organization.

We ensure that the children have access to clean drinking water by installing deep wells. We construct toilets and showers with cesspools, renovate or build kitchens and dormitories, and set up small clinics. Teachers and children receive repeated instructions in hygiene and preventive health. In addition, we monitor the health statistics of the orphanages. As a result, we were able to improve the health of our girls and boys perceptibly and sustainably.
